

Instructions

1. For best sound, outlet hole should be facing towards your body.
2. Simply blow into the mouthpiece tube with controlled, short bursts of air. Use the cadence "Who cooks for you. Who cooks for you all!" Repeat as often as necessary.
3. **DO NOT** cover the outlet hole. This will reduce all tones.
4. The H.S. STRUT "Barred" Owl Hooter is designed to achieve maximum range for locating wild turkeys.

Helpful Tips

- Gobblers will naturally reply and reveal their positions when they hear this call. Change locations if you get no response after several series of calls.
- Unlike wooden calls, the H.S. STRUT will not warp after exposure to moisture. **ALWAYS** store away from intense heat.
- Practice outdoors as well as indoors: sounds will vary.

The H.S. STRUT "Barred" Owl Hooter is unmatched for locating "gobblers" during spring. It consistently delivers loud, exceptionally true tones because of its modern design and materials.

To locate wild turkeys, begin by making soft "gobbler aggravating" calls while positioned on the fringe of your hunting area (hills and higher elevations are best for hearing). Increase volume, if necessary. After getting a response, circle into the general location of the bird. Repeat calls for exact position. For best game-getting results, use H.S. STRUT slate or box calls to bring bird near to range. Use H.S. STRUT diaphragm calls to draw bird in close.
