

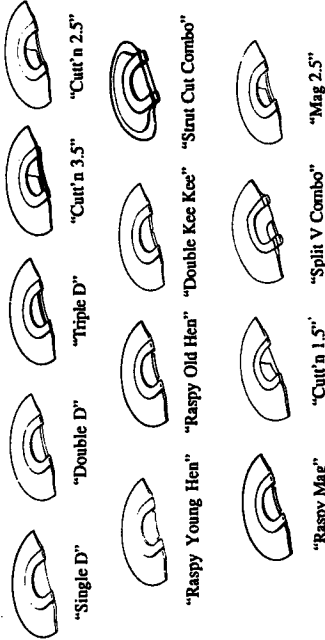
Instructions (Do Not Bend Call!)

Premium Flex™ calls are designed to form to the roof of your mouth without bending and require much less air pressure than conventional aluminum frame calls. Premium Flex™ calls are pre-set to exact consistency and require no break-in period.

1. With open end of horseshoe facing out, insert diaphragm into roof of mouth. (Small bump on back should be down.)
2. Place center of tongue on latex and push firmly against roof of mouth with tip of tongue against bottom of front teeth. Before attempting sounds, practice tolerating and controlling call in roof of mouth.
3. To get a sound, huff from throat by forcing air between latex and tongue. More tongue pressure creates high notes, less for low notes.
4. To produce a yelp, take a deep breath and block all air flow from throat with back of tongue. Next, say the word "chick" with the same speed and volume you wish to yelp. To achieve desired double high/low notes, drop jaw slightly as releasing tongue pressure toward end of yelp. With practice you will be able to make all sounds the call was designed for.

Helpful Tips

- DO NOT leave calls in direct sunlight or store in glove compartment of vehicle.
 - Store in refrigerator when not in use. Make sure call is completely dry.
 - Keep in handy carrying case.
 - DO NOT pull or tamper with reeds before or during storage.
 - If diaphragm feels uncomfortable, trim the outside tape section to a smaller width using scissors. BE CAREFUL to trim only very small amounts and repeatedly try new fit. DO NOT cut into latex reeds.
 - Practice outdoors as well as indoors: sounds will vary.
- CAUTION: ANY DIAPHRAGM TURKEY CALL CAN BE CHOKED ON WHEN PLACED INTO THE MOUTH.**
